

CHAPTER 77

Original House Bill No. 210

MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERS

AN ACT to amend section 31-53 (c) of the statutes relating to motor vehicle dealer licensing requirements; and changing the number of motor vehicles required to be sold in the previous calendar year for dealers in business less than a full year.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. Section 31-53 (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

31-53. Definitions.

(c) Motor vehicle dealer: Any person engaged in the business of selling or exchanging new or used motor vehicles, or both and who sells, or exchanges ten or more new or new and used or used motor vehicles in the previous calendar year. The requirement of selling or exchanging ten vehicles shall not apply to dealers selling self-propelled motor homes and drilling and service rigs and these dealers shall still have the right to obtain dealer plates. However, persons engaged in the business of selling or exchanging new or used motor vehicles, or both, for less than the entire previous calendar year are only required to have sold or exchanged an average of one motor vehicle for each whole month during the preceding calendar year for which a motor vehicle dealer's license was held, not exceeding a total of ten. The provisions of this subsection are applicable to any person applying for a dealer certificate for the first time. Any person engaged in the business of making loans secured by motor vehicles may be a dealer for the purpose of securing dealer license plates upon payment of the fees required of dealers by this act, may acquire dealer plates and use the same solely for the purpose of repossession and sale of motor vehicles.
