

CHAPTER 57

ICF/MR APPROPRIATION

Original House Bill No. 8

AN ACT to amend W.S. 42-4-103(a)(xxii); and to repeal Wyoming Session Laws 1988, Chapter 34, Section 6 relating to intermediate care facilities; expanding intermediate care facilities which can provide services; appropriating money for the intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded, for capital construction and for day care programs through the state training school and community residential, day and vocational placement through the division of community programs; requiring a report on day care programs; authorizing additional employees; authorizing the appropriations to be revised or redistributed as specified; repealing the sunset for the ICF/MR; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 42-4-103(a)(xxii) is amended to read:

42-4-103. Authorized services and supplies.

(a) Services and supplies authorized for medical assistance under this chapter include:

(xxii) Services provided by an intermediate care facility as defined under 42 U.S.C. § 1396d(c);

Section 2.

(a) For the 1991-1992 biennium, there is appropriated to the state training school the following sums for Phase II of the intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded:

(b) The board of charities and reform shall evaluate the cost effectiveness of intermediate care facility day programming funded under subsection (a) of this section and on or before December 1, 1990, report evaluation results to the legislature.

Section 3. The state training school is authorized 61 full-time positions for the purposes of section 1 of this act.

Section 4. For the 1991-1992 biennium, there is appropriated to the department of health and social services, division of community programs, from the general fund one million four hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$1,470,000.00) to provide community residential, day and vocational placement for persons placed in community programs from the state training school.

Section 5. Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1005(a)(iv), (viii) and (x), (b)(i) and (c)(i), upon recommendation of the board of charities and reform, the administrator of the division of health and medical services and the superintendent of the state training school, the governor may authorize revisions, changes or redistributions to the appropriations and approved budget associated with this act. Any revisions, changes or redistributions and a brief explanation of the reasons therefore shall be distributed to members of the joint appropriations committee within thirty (30) days after the revision, change or redistribution.

Section 6. Wyoming Session Laws 1988, Chapter 34, Section 6 is repealed.

Section 7. This act is effective July 1, 1990.
