
AN ACT to amend and re-enact section 6-192, Wyoming Statutes 1957,
 relating to the offense of intentionally destroying or injuring
 a public jail or other place of confinement, and providing a
 penalty.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. Section 6-192, Wyoming Statutes 1957, is hereby
amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

8 If-any ANY person WHO shall wilfully and intentionally break 9 down, pull down, or otherwise destroy or injure, in whole or in 10 part, any public jail, or other place of LAWFUL confinement, every 11 person-so-offending, shall, upon conviction, be fined-in-any-sum 12 not-exceeding-five-thousand-dollars, nor-less-than MADE TO PAY the 13 value of such jail or place of confinement so destroyed, or THE 14 COST OF REPAIRING of such injury as may have been done thereto by such unlawful act, TO WHICH MAY BE ADDED A FINE IN ANY AMOUNT NOT 15 16 TO EXCEED FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00), OR IMPRISONMENT IN 17 THE COUNTY JAIL NOT TO EXCEED ONE (1) YEAR, OR BOTH SUCH FINE 18 AND IMPRISONMENT.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

6 Section 1. Section 6-192, Wyoming Statutes 1957, is7 hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

8 If-any ANY person WHO shall wilfully and intentionally break down, pull down, or otherwise destroy or injure, in whole 9 or in part, any public jail, or other place of LAWFUL confinement, 10 every-person-so-offending shall, upon conviction, be fined-in-any 11 12 sum-not-exceeding-five-thousand-dollars,-nor-less-than MADE TO PAY the-value-of-such-jail-or-place-of-confinement-so-destroyed, 13 14 of THE COST OF REPAIRING of such injury OR DAMAGE TO SAID JAIL 15 OR PLACE OF CONFINEMENT as may have been done thereto by such unlawful act, TO WHICH MAY BE ADDED A FINE IN ANY AMOUNT NOT 16 TO EXCEED FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00), OR IMPRISONMENT 17 IN THE COUNTY JAIL NOT TO EXCEED ONE (1) YEAR, OR BOTH SUCH 18 FINE AND IMPRISONMENT. 19
