- 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
- 6 Section 1. W.S. 3-5-104 is created to read:
- 7 3-5-104. GIFTS UNDER POWER OF ATTORNEY.
- 8 (a) If any power of attorney or other writing autho-
- 9 rizes an attorney in fact or agent to do, execute or per-
- 10 form any act that the principal might or could do, or evi-
- 11 dences the principal's intent to give the attorney in fact

- or agent full power to handle the principal's affairs or
- deal with the principal's property, the attorney in fact
- 3 or agent shall have the power and authority to make gifts
- 4 in any amount of any of the principal's property to any
- 5 individuals or to organizations described in sections
- 6 170(c) and 2522(a) of the Internal Revenue Code or corre-
- 7 sponding provisions of federal tax law, or both, in accor-
- 8 dance with the principal's personal history of making or
- 9 joining in the making of lifetime gifts.
- 10 (b) Subsection (a) of this section shall not in any
- way impair the right or power of any principal, by express
- words in the power of attorney or other writing, to autho-
- 13 rize, or limit the authority of, any attorney in fact or
- other agent to make gifts of the principal's property.
- 15 (c) After reasonable notice to the principal, an
- 16 attorney in fact or other agent acting under a durable
- 17 general power of attorney or other writing may petition
- 18 the district court for authority to make gifts of the
- 19 principal's property to the extent not inconsistent with
- 20 the express terms of the power of attorney or other writ-
- 21 ing. The court shall determine the amounts, recipients
- 22 and proportions of any gifts of the principal's property
- 23 after considering all relevant factors including, without

2	(i) The size of the principal's estate;
3	(ii) The principal's foreseeable obligations and
4	maintenance needs;
5	(iii) The principal's personal history of mak-
6	ing, or joining in the making of, lifetime gifts;
7	(iv) The principal's estate plan; and
8	(v) The tax effects of the gifts.
9	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 1995.
