- 4 ENTIRE STATE OF WYOMING;
- 5 <u>27-4-405</u>. Duty of public authority to ascertain wage
- 6 rate for public works; requirement as to call for bids.
- 7 Before any public body awards a contract for (a) 8 public works, it shall ascertain OBTAIN the prevailing 9 hourly rate of wages in the locality in which the work is 10 to be performed, for each craft or type of workman needed 11 to execute the contract or project FROM THE MOST RECENT SURVEY RESULTS CERTIFIED BY THE COMMISSIONER. THE 12 SIONER SHALL SEMIANNUALLY CONDUCT AND PUBLISH THE RESULTS 13 OF A SURVEY TO ASCERTAIN THE PREVAILING HOURLY RATE 14 15 WAGES FOR WORKERS IN BUILDING WORK CLASSIFICATIONS CALCU-LATED ON A STATEWIDE BASIS. The public body shall specify 16 in the resolution or ordinance and in the call for bids 17 18 for the contract, what the prevailing hourly rate of wages in the locality is for each craft or type of workman 19 20 needed to execute the contract, and it shall be mandatory upon the contractor to whom the contract is awarded and 21 22 upon any subcontractor under him, to pay not less than the

1 specified rates to all workmen employed by them in the execution of the contract. The public body awarding the 2 3 contract shall cause to be inserted in the contract a stipulation to the effect that not less than the prevail-4 ing hourly rate of wages as found by the public body, the 5 6 commissioner, or determined by the court on review, shall 7 be paid to all workmen performing work under the contract. It shall also require in all the contractor's bonds that 8 9 the contractor include such provision as will guarantee the faithful performance of the prevailing hourly wage 10 clause as provided by the contract. The 11 finding CERTIFICATION of the COMMISSIONER TO THE public body 12 awarding the contract or authorizing the work, ascertain-13 14 ing and declaring prevailing hourly rate of wages, shall 15 be final for all purposes of the contract then being considered, unless reviewed under the provisions of this act. 16 A public body doing public works directly shall comply 17 18 with the prevailing hourly rate of wages portion of this 19 section of the act for each craft or type of workman so employed. 20

21 Section 2. This act is effective May 23, 1985.
