A BILL

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing an amendment to Article 10,  
2 Section 4 of the Constitution of the State of Wyoming to  
3 provide that the legislature may by law limit the amount  
4 of damages to be recovered in cases of personal injury or  
5 death.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,  
7 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting  
8 separately, concurring therein:

9 Section 1. The following amendment to Article 10,  
10 Section 4 of the Wyoming Constitution is proposed for sub-  
11 mission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the  
12 next general election for approval or rejection, to become

1 valid as a part of the constitution if ratified by a  
2 majority of the electors voting at the election. The  
3 amendment is as follows:

4 Article 10, Section 4. Damages for personal injuries  
5 or death can be limited; worker's compensation. No law  
6 ~~shall-be-enacted-limiting~~ THE LEGISLATURE MAY ENACT LAWS  
7 TO LIMIT the amount of damages to be recovered for causing  
8 the injury or death of any person. Any contract or agree-  
9 ment with any employee waiving any right to recover dam-  
10 ages for causing the death or injury of any employee shall  
11 be void. As to all extrahazardous employments the legis-  
12 lature shall provide by law for the accumulation and main-  
13 tenance of a fund or funds out of which shall be paid com-  
14 pensation as may be fixed by law according to proper clas-  
15 sifications to each person injured in such employment or  
16 to the dependent families of such as die as the result of  
17 such injuries, except in case of injuries due solely to  
18 the culpable negligence of the injured employee. The fund  
19 or funds shall be accumulated, paid into the state trea-  
20 sury and maintained in such manner as may be provided by  
21 law. The right of each employee to compensation from the  
22 fund shall be in lieu of and shall take the place of any  
23 and all rights of action against any employer contributing  
24 as required by law to the fund in favor of any person or

1 persons by reason of the injuries or death. Subject to  
2 conditions specified by law, the legislature may allow  
3 employments not designated extrahazardous to be covered by  
4 the state fund at the option of the employer. To the  
5 extent an employer elects to be covered by the state fund  
6 and contributes to the fund as required by law, the  
7 employer shall enjoy the same immunity as provided for  
8 extrahazardous employments.

9 Section 2. The following statement shall be endorsed  
10 on the foregoing proposed amendment by the Secretary of  
11 State of Wyoming:

12 The adoption of this amendment will provide that the  
13 legislature may limit the amount of damages to be recov-  
14 ered in cases of personal injury or death.
