Mission and philosophy

Develop rules setting uniform and reasonable standards of competency for the practice and teaching of cosmetology; administer board examinations; inspect establishments for proper licensure and sanitation; initiate and conduct investigations, hearings, and proceedings concerning violations of the Cosmetology Act and rules and regulations of the board; apply disciplinary action when necessary; determine fees; employ an executive director and additional staff as necessary.

Results of outcomes.

Six board examinations were administered, whereby 187 examinees were tested.

The board inspected 616 salons and 11 schools.

Sanitation rules were revised to meet national standards.

Thirteen complaints were investigated, with one resulting in disciplinary action.

The board will continue to upgrade its record keeping and licensure process.

The board will implement a better record system concerning student records and school reports and continue to expand on the newsletter to keep the industry better informed.

Cosmetology curriculum will be updated to better meet the needs of the industry.
