1 A Bill for an act to repeal,
2 amend and re-enact section
3 three of Chapter Eighty eight of the
4 Compiled Laws of Wyoming Territory.

6 Be it enacted by the Council
7 and House of Representatives of the
8 Territory of Wyoming:

10 Section 1. That section three of
11 Chapter Eighty eight of the Compiled
12 Laws of Wyoming Territory be and
13 the same is hereby repealed,
14 and the following enacted in
15 lieu thereof: Section 3. Each
16 person so appointed to the
17 office of notary public, shall,
18 within thirty days from the
19 date of his commission, file with
20 the County Clerk and Ex-officio
21 Register of Deeds in whose office

his commission is filed for record,
a bond executed by himself and
two sureties, to be approved
by said County Clerk and Ex-
officio Register of Deeds, which
bond shall run to the Territory
of Wyoming in the sum of five
hundred dollars, conditioned
for the faithful performance of
the duties of his office, and shall
take and subscribe an oath
or affirmation before the County
Clerk and Ex-officio Register
of Deeds or before any notary
public or justice of the peace
of the county for which he was

appointed; that he will support
the constitution of the United States
and the Organic law of the Territory
of Wyoming; and that he will
faithfully and impartially discharge
and perform all the duties of the
office of notary public, and the
County Clerk and Ex-officio Register
of deeds shall preserve such bond
and oath in his office, and record
the commission and oath in a
book to be kept by him for that
purpose, and shall send to the
Secretary of the Territory a written
notice that the requirements of
the law have been complied with.

which notice the secretary shall
preserve in his office.

Sec 2. This act shall take
effect and be in force from
and after its passage.
