8 Section 1. That Subsection (a) of Section 15.1-16,  
9 Wyoming Statutes 1957, Compiled 1965, is hereby amended and re-enacted  
10 to read as follows:

11 (a) Every ordinance before becoming effective shall be  
12 published at least once ~~BY TITLE ONLY~~ *(Cap) and may be published in full or (Cap)* in a newspaper of  
13 general circulation within the city or town. ~~If there is no~~  
14 ~~such newspaper, then~~ The ENTIRE ordinance shall ALSO be posted  
15 for at least ten days in the city clerk's office and such  
16 other places as the governing body may determine. Emergency  
17 ordinances shall become effective upon proclamation of the  
18 mayor, and as soon ~~thereafter~~ *(Cap)* THEREAFTER as is practicable  
19 they shall be published and posted in the manner required of  
20 other ordinances, *and copies of such ordinances shall be made*  
21 *available to those persons requesting*  
22 *same and upon payment of the cost*  
*thereof.*  
TITLE ONLY, PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION, IN

1 CONFORMANCE WITH SECTION 15.1-15, WYOMING STATUTES 1957, AS AMENDED,  
2 IS HEREBY DEEMED TO HAVE BEEN PUBLISHED IN FULL COMPLIANCE WITH ALL  
3 STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS WITH RESPECT TO PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCES.

16 places as the governing body may determine. Emergency ordinances  
17 shall become effective upon proclamation of the mayor, and as soon  
18 ~~thereafter~~ THEREAFTER as is practicable they shall be published and  
19 posted in the manner required of other ordinances, AND COPIES OF SUCH  
20 ORDINANCES SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THOSE PERSONS REQUESTING SAME AND  
21 UPON PAYMENT OF THE COST THEREOF.

22 (i) EVERY ORDINANCE WHICH HAS BEEN PUBLISHED BY TITLE ONLY,  
23 PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION, IN CONFORMANCE WITH

1 SECTION 15.1-15, WYOMING STATUTES 1957, AS AMENDED, IS HEREBY DEEMED TO  
2 HAVE BEEN PUBLISHED IN FULL COMPLIANCE WITH ALL STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS  
3 WITH RESPECT TO PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCES.
