

CHAPTER 17

INSURANCE AGENTS-CONTINUING EDUCATION

Original House Bill No. 77

AN ACT to amend W.S. 26-9-141(a) and (f) relating to insurance; requiring continuing education for title insurance agents; specifying continuing education requirements for non-resident licensees; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 26-9-141(a) and (f) is amended to read:

26-9-141. CONTINUING EDUCATION.

(a) Resident agents, brokers, solicitors, title agents licensed pursuant to W.S. 26-23-318, service representatives, adjusters, nonresident licensees and other persons required to be licensed under this chapter shall annually complete ten (10) classroom hours of continuing education. This

requirement does not apply to those persons who hold licenses for any kinds of insurance for which an examination is not required, nor shall it apply to any such limited or restricted licenses as the commissioner may exempt.

(f) Every person subject to this section shall furnish, in a form satisfactory to the commissioner, written certification as to the courses, programs or seminars of instruction taken by that person. The certification shall be executed by or on behalf of the sponsoring organization within a sixty (60) day period following the course, program or seminar. Notwithstanding subsections (a), (d) and (e) of this section, a nonresident licensee may satisfy the continuing education requirements of this section by providing the commissioner with evidence, in a form satisfactory to the commissioner, of compliance with the continuing education requirement of his state of domicile. A nonresident licensee domiciled in a state without a continuing education requirement is subject to the requirements of this section.

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
