1 A JOINT MEMORIAL, memorializing the honorable Norman  
2 Barlow, late President of the Senate of the Wyoming  
3 Legislature, and expressing deep appreciation for his  
4 untiring and devoted service to the state.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

6 WHEREAS, Norman Barlow of Cora, Wyoming was born on  
7 October 1, 1905; and

8 WHEREAS, Norman Barlow served two terms in the House  
9 of Representatives and four terms in the Senate of the  
10 Wyoming Legislature, serving as President of the Senate  
11 during the 1959-1961 session; and

12 WHEREAS, Norman Barlow served as President of the  
13 Wyoming Stockgrowers Association during 1955 to 1957; and

14 WHEREAS, Norman Barlow served in various capacities  
15 with the Upper Colorado River Commission and was a repre-  
16 sentative of the State of Wyoming when the Upper Colorado

1 River Compact was signed; and

2 WHEREAS, Norman Barlow worked tirelessly throughout  
3 his career for the well being of the people of this State;  
4 and

5 WHEREAS, Norman Barlow possessed courage, honesty and  
6 integrity in the highest measure, and personified con-  
7 sideration of his state and his fellow man, his example  
8 serving constantly to remind us of our responsibilities  
9 and to inspire us to fulfill them conscientiously;

10 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Senate of the 42nd  
11 Legislature of the State of Wyoming, the House of Repre-  
12 sentatives of said Legislature concurring, that we express  
13 our deep sense of loss and sorrow caused by the passing of  
14 our long-time associate and beloved friend.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a room be set aside and  
16 established in the west wing of the capitol building to be  
17 known and designated as the Senate memorial room, where  
18 donations made in memory of Norman Barlow and other  
19 deceased Senators may be appropriately housed and dis-  
20 played.

21 IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this memorial be  
22 transmitted to the family of Norman Barlow, deceased, so  
23 that they may be assured of the deep love and respect in

1     which we held him and of our profound sense of loss at his  
2     passing.
