<u>LETTER ORDER</u> (Issued February 4, 2021)

Dear Counsel:

On January 29, 2021, Walmart, Inc. (Walmart) submitted *Walmart Inc.'s Petition for Leave for Witness Steve W. Chriss to appear remotely, and for Walmart to participate in the proceedings remotely and on a limited basis (Petition)*. Support for the request includes the distance the witness would need to travel, Walmart's concern for employee travel due to the COVID-19 health crisis, and that the witness's direct testimony is already on file with the Commission. Additionally, Walmart has a limited interest the matter and cross-examination, if any, will be limited. No parties oppose the request.

Walmart's *Petition* came before the Commission at the Prehearing conference on February 3, 2021. The Commission having considered the *Petition* and reviewing the file, finds Walmart has shown good cause supporting its request and that the *Petition* should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. Pursuant to action taken during the Prehearing conference held on February 3, 2021 Walmart's *Petition for Leave for Witness Steve W. Chriss to appear remotely, and for Walmart to participate in the proceedings remotely and on a limited basis* filed on January 29, 2021, is granted.
 - 2. This *Letter Order* is effective immediately.
