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37-2-121. When rate to be changed by commission; 14 nontraditional rate making. 15

17 (a) If upon hearing and investigation, any rate shall 18 be found by the commission ţο be inadequate

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unremunerative, or to be unjust, or unreasonable, 1 unjustly discriminatory, or unduly preferential or otherwise 2 in any respect in violation of any provision of this act, 3 the commission may fix and order substituted therefor such 4 rate as it shall determine to be just and reasonable and in 5 compliance with the provisions of this act. Such rate so 6 ascertained, determined and fixed by the commission shall be 7 charged, enforced, collected and observed by the public 8 utility for the period of time fixed by the commission. The 9 rates may contain provisions for incentives for improvement 10 of the public utility's performance or efficiency, lowering 11 of operating costs, control of expenses or improvement and 12 upgrading or modernization of its services or facilities. 13 Any public utility may apply to the commission for its 14 consent to use innovative, incentive or nontraditional rate 15 making methods. In conducting any investigation and holding 16 any hearing in response thereto, the commission may consider 17 18 and approve proposals which include any rate, regulation, rate setting concept, economic development rate, 19 service concept, nondiscriminatory revenue sharing or 20 profit-sharing form of regulation and policy, including 21 policies for the encouragement of the development of public 22 utility infrastructure, services, facilities or plant within 23 the state, which can be shown by substantial evidence to 24 support and be consistent with the public interest. 25

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2	(b) For purposes of implementing gas supply commodity
3	competition in retail natural gas markets, the commission
4	shall, on or prior to July 1, 1998:
5	
6	(i) Require every natural gas public utility as
7	defined by W.S. 37-1-101(a)(vi)(D) to file unbundled rates,
8	terms and conditions for gas utility distribution service
9	which allow retail customers, including residential
10	customers, the opportunity to select among competing natural
11	gas commodity suppliers;
12	
13	(ii) Provide for recovery by natural gas public
14	utilities of all prudently incurred transition costs,
15	including gas supply realignment and stranded costs;
16	
17	(iii) Require that a natural gas public utility
18	have unbundled tariff provisions in effect for its own
19	service territory pursuant to this subsection before it, or
20	any of its affiliated companies, may compete for natural gas
21	supply commodity sales within the service territory of other
22	natural gas public utilities;
23	
24	(iv) Promulgate rules necessary to implement this
25	subsection.
