

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

6 Section 1. W.S. 27-4-413 is amended to read:

7 27-4-413. Inapplicability and exemptions from arti-
 8 cle. The provisions of ~~this act, shall~~ W.S. 27-4-401
 9 THROUGH 27-4-115, DO not ~~be applicable~~ APPLY where in
 10 conflict with federal statutes, rules or regulations
 11 relating to prevailing wage determinations. All work and

1 labor performed by prisoners, patients and other inmates
2 of state penal, correctional and charitable institutions
3 and city or county jails, ~~are-exempt-from-the-provisions~~
4 ~~of-this-act~~ AND ALL WORK AND LABOR PERFORMED BY WORKMEN
5 REGULARLY EMPLOYED BY THE PUBLIC BODY ARE EXEMPT FROM THE
6 PROVISIONS OF W.S. 27-4-401 THROUGH 27-4-115.

7 Section 2. This act is effective May 25, 1979.
