6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 39-6-302 by creating a new subsection
9 (aa) is amended to read:

10

11 **39-6-302. Excise taxes on extraction of minerals.**

13 (aa) In addition to the other excise taxes provided
14 for in this section, there is hereby levied upon the
15 privilege of extracting trona and coal an excise tax of one
16 and one-half percent (1 1/2%) of the value of the gross
17 product extracted. The proceeds from the tax are payable to

1 the department of revenue and shall be deposited in the
2 public school capitol construction account under W.S.
3 21-15-106.

5 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 1998.
