- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 39-6-302 by creating a new subsection
- 9 (aa) is amended to read:

39-6-302. Excise taxes on extraction of minerals.

- 13 (aa) In addition to the other excise taxes provided
- 14 for in this section, there is hereby levied upon the
- 15 privilege of extracting trona and coal an excise tax of one
- 16 and one-half percent (1 1/2%) of the value of the gross
- 17 product extracted. The proceeds from the tax are payable to

the department of revenue and shall be deposited in the
public school capitol construction account under W.S.

21-15-106.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 1998.
