- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,
- 7 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting
- 8 separately, concurring therein:
- 9 Section 1. The following proposal to amend Wyoming
- 10 Constitution, Article 15, Section 11(a)(intro), (ii) and
- 11 by creating a new paragraph (iii) and by renumbering (iii)
- 12 as (iv) and (b) is proposed for submission to the electors

- 5 ARTICLE 15, SECTION 11. UNIFORMITY OF ASSESSMENT
- 6 REQUIRED.
- 7 (a) All property, except as in this constitution
- 8 otherwise provided, shall be uniformly valued at its full
- 9 value as defined by the legislature, in three-{3} four (4)
- 10 classes as follows:
- 11 (ii) Property used for industrial purposes as
- 12 defined by the legislature; and
- 13 (iii) Real, personal and commercial residential
- 14 property as defined and valued by the legislature; and
- 15 (iii) (iv) All other property, real and personal.
- 16 (b) The legislature shall prescribe the percentage of
- 17 value which shall be assessed within each designated
- 18 class. All taxable property shall be valued at its full
- 19 value as defined by the legislature except agricultural
- 20 and grazing lands which shall be valued according to the
- 21 capability of the land to produce agricultural products

- under normal conditions, and real, personal and commercial
- 2 residential property which shall be valued as defined by
- 3 the legislature. The percentage of value prescribed for
- 4 industrial property shall not be more than forty percent
- 5 (40%) higher nor more than four (4) percentage points more
- 6 than the percentage prescribed for property other than
- 7 minerals.
- 8 Section 2. The Secretary of State shall endorse the
- 9 following statement on the proposed amendment:
- 10 The adoption of this amendment will create an addi-
- 11 tional class of property for taxation purposes. The addi-
- 12 tional class will consist of real, personal and commercial
- 13 residential property to be defined by the legislature.
- 14 Assessment of property within this class must be uniform
- 15 but may differ from the other three classes of property
- 16 currently defined in the constitution.
