HOSPITAL DISTRICT-POWERS

Original House Bill No. 246

AN ACT relating to counties; providing for powers of a memorial hospital, special hospital district or rural health care district as specified; requiring approval as specified; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 18-8-301(a)(intro) and by creating a new subsection (d) is amended to read:

18-8-301. Additional powers; requirements and conditions; approval by governing body.

(a) Subject to the requirements of this section, any county memorial hospital, special hospital district established under W.S. 35-2-401 through 35-2-438 and rural health care district established under W.S. 35-2-701 through 35-2-709 may, either within the county of its establishment or without, within this state or without:

(d) No county memorial hospital, special hospital district or rural health care district shall exercise any authority granted by subsection (a) of this section in any Wyoming municipality in which a hospital currently exists unless and until that hospital has been given an opportunity to participate with the undertaking hospital, special hospital district or rural health care district.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
