DIRECTIONS.

Adults should take a tablespoonful before each meal.

Ladies and delicate persons should always commence with a teaspoonful, and gradually increase to the dose best suited to their condition, strength, or constitutional peculiarities.

For Coughs, Colds, Consumption, or any disease of the Lungs, Bronchial Tubes or Throat, a teaspoonful every hour during the day will often have a better effect than the large doses. In fact, in many cases half a teaspoonful every half hour will have the very best effect.

In Cramp of the Stomach, whether vomiting or not, in severe Neuralgia pain in the head, or brain, or anywhere else, a wineglassful should be taken every half hour until relieved; after that the usual dose. In Cholera and in Yellow Fever take it in the wineglassful doses.

Children from two years up, a teaspoonful before each meal, three times daily, by itself, or in sweetened milk. Infants at six months a half teaspoonful in sweetened milk, and, if colicky, it may be repeated as often as necessary.

The undersigned, Samuel B. Hartman of Columbus, Ohio, being duly sworn on oath says that he is the true and lawful owner of the trade-mark called PE-RU-NA and its labels, wrappers or forms of advertisement as herewith filed, and manufactured by The Peruna Medicine company of the city of Columbus, Ohio, and makes this statement in his behalf in pursuance of Chapter 5, Laws of 1899 of the State of Wyoming with reference to the Registration and protection of Labels and Trade-marks.

That he files herewith two copies which are counterparts or facsimiles of a certain trade-mark named PE-RU-NA and its labels, wrappers or forms of advertisement described as follows:


One, an inside wrapper placed upon the bottle giving directions for the use of PE-RU-NA, and a history of the preparation which is in four columns, two in German and two in English, and which is signed by The Peruna Medicine Co., Columbus, Ohio, as manufactured and put up by it; also a neck label as per copy enclosed herewith, which gives notice that the floating specks in the bottle do not impair the virtue of the medicine; also another which is placed over the neck and cork of the bottle which will pay one cent on demand and which is signed by The Peruna Medicine Co., and an outside wrapper which contains the following: "PE-RU-NA THE GREAT TONIC", which are the usual methods of using said trade-mark and its labels, wrappers or forms of advertisement herewith filed; that he has adopted these terms to appropriate them for the purpose of denoting, making known or distinguishing the product of his manufacture, to wit:

A Proprietary Medicine called PE-RU-NA.


That he has the right to use the said PE-RU-NA, its labels, supplemental labels or forms of advertisement, and that no other person, firm or association has the right to use either the identical form herein set forth or any such near resemblance thereto as may be calculated to de-

ceive and that the facsimiles, copies or counterparts filed herewith are true and correct.

The essential part of said trade-mark is the word PE-RU-NA, which may be used either written or printed, with hyphens between the syllables or without, or used by itself or in connection with other words or sentences.
