5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

6 Section 1. W.S. 12-2-201 by creating a new subsec-
 7 tion (f) is amended to read:

8 12-2-201. Wholesale license for sale of malt bever-
 9 ages only; fee; restrictions.

10 (f) IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR A BREWER, ITS AGENT OR SUB-
 11 SIDIARY, TO SELL MALT BEVERAGES MANUFACTURED OUTSIDE THIS

1 STATE TO A LICENSED MALT BEVERAGE WHOLESALER WITHIN THIS
2 STATE AT A PRICE HIGHER THAN THAT AT WHICH THE SAME PROD-
3 UCT IN AN IDENTICAL SIZE, CONTAINER AND PACKAGE IS SOLD OR
4 OFFERED TO ANY OTHER WHOLESALER IN THE UNITED STATES. THE
5 SIZE OR TYPE OF WHOLESALER SHALL BE IMMATERIAL, AND THE
6 BREWER, ITS AGENT OR SUBSIDIARY, SHALL OFFER THE IDENTICAL
7 QUANTITY DISCOUNTS, CASH REBATES AND OTHER FORMS OF DIS-
8 COUNTS TO A LICENSED WYOMING WHOLESALER AS ARE OFFERED ANY
9 OTHER WHOLESALER IN THE UNITED STATES FOR THE SAME MER-
10 CHANDISE.

11 Section 2. This act is effective May 25, 1979.
