An Act providing for the Appointment of Bailiffs of the District Courts and Fixing their Duties and Compensations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. The judges of the district courts of the several districts of this state are hereby authorized and empowered to appoint one bailiff in each county for the district court in and for said county, and said bailiff shall hold his said appointment during the pleasure of the judge of such district.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of such bailiff to attend the sessions of said court, to preserve order therein, to execute and serve such orders and process as the court or the judge may direct, and to perform such other duties as may be incident to his said position of bailiff and required of him by such court or judge.

Section 3. For the services specified in the preceding section such bailiff shall receive a compensation of three dollars for each day the court shall be in session, ~~and when not in session, the sum of three dollars per day for such services as may be performed by such bailiff under the orders and direction of the judge of such court, which compensation shall be paid by the county in and for the court of which such bailiff may be appointed.~~

Section 4. It shall be the duty of such bailiff to make out an account for the services performed by him as such bailiff, against the proper county in the manner provided by Section 1805 of the Revised Statutes of Wyoming; which said account shall also be certified to by the judge of such court, stating that the services specified in said account have been performed by such bailiff; and such account so made out and certified shall be filed with the county clerk of the proper county, and ~~shall~~ be paid in the same manner as all other accounts against the county.

Section 5. This act shall take effect and be in force
