7	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
8	Section 1. The purpose of this act is to provide
9	state funds to municipalities and counties in times of

disaster or emergency that endangers the health, safety

- and welfare of the people of Wyoming, when municipal or
- 2 county services are essential to the preservation of life
- 3 and property and cannot reasonably be provided or funded
- 4 by other means.
- 5 Section 2.
- 6 (a) Eight million dollars (\$8,000,000.00) is appro-
- 7 priated from the state general fund to be expended to
- 8 assist municipalities and counties to meet disasters and
- 9 emergencies which endanger human life, wildlife, domestic
- 10 animals or property or cause extreme hardships in munici-
- 11 palities or counties.
- 12 (b) Funds shall be granted to municipalities and
- 13 counties upon request by the governing body to the gover-
- 14 nor, subject to section 3 of this act, and upon a showing
- 15 that:
- 16 (i) A disaster or emergency exists;
- 17 (ii) The welfare or best interest of the
- 18 people, wildlife, domestic animals, or property is endan-
- 19 gered; and
- 20 (iii) The local funds are inadequate or
- 21 unavailable to provide the public services necessary as a

- 1 result of the disaster or emergency.
- 2 (c) The appropriation shall not be used to advance
- 3 funds to state agencies unless revenues otherwise avail-
- 4 able under W.S. 9-7-509 are exhausted and then only upon
- 5 compliance with W.S. 9-7-509(c) and only for emergencies
- 6 defined under this act.
- 7 Section 3. Requests for funds under section 2 of
- 8 this act shall be submitted by the governor to the secre-
- 9 tary of state, state treasurer, state auditor and state
- 10 superintendent of public instruction. The funds may be
- 11 expended upon majority approval of the five elected state
- 12 officials.
- 13 Section 4. At the legislative session next following
- 14 the expenditures made out of this appropriation, the
- 15 governor shall report to the legislature the name of each
- 16 governmental entity receiving a grant, the amount of each
- 17 grant, and the purpose for which each grant was made pur-
- 18 suant to this act.

1 Section 5. This act is effective immediately upon

2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Con-

4 stitution.
