8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

9 Section 1. Section 39-164, Wyoming Statutes 1957, as
10 amended and re-enacted by Section 1, Chapter 112, Session Laws
11 of Wyoming 1961, is amended and re-enacted to read as follows:
12 (a) There is hereby levied and shall be collected and
13 paid to the state board of equalization a tax upon the use or storage
14 by consumers of cigarettes in this state only in the event that the
15 tax imposed by ~~the preceding section~~ SECTION 39-163 OF THIS ACT
16 has not been paid, as follows: ~~two (2)~~ THREE AND ONE-HALF (3½)
17 mills on each cigarette.

18 (b) On or before the 20th day of each calendar month
19 every such consumer, who during the preceding calendar month has

1 acquired title to, or possession of cigarettes for use or storage
2 in this state, upon which cigarettes the tax imposed by ~~the preceding~~
3 ~~section~~ SECTION 39-163 OF THIS ACT has not been paid, shall file a
4 return with the state board of equalization showing the quantity of
5 cigarettes so acquired and accompany said return with a remittance
6 for the full unpaid tax liability shown ~~thereof~~ THEREON.

18 (b) On or before the 20th day of each calendar month every such
19 consumer, who during the preceding calendar month has acquired title to,

1 or possession of cigarettes for use or storage in this state, upon which
2 cigarettes the tax imposed by ~~the preceeding section~~ SECTION 39-163 WYOMING
3 STATUTES 1957 AS AMENDED has not been paid, shall file a return with the
4 state board of equalization showing the quantity of cigarettes so
5 acquired and accompany said return with a remittance for the full unpaid
6 tax liability shown ~~thereof~~ THEREON.

7 Section 2. This act shall be in force and effect from and after
8 July 1, 1967.
