BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That Section 47-203, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 88, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1949, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person of the age of fourteen (14) years or over to catch, pursue, or attempt to catch any fish in this State in any manner whatsoever without first having obtained a proper license or permit from the Commission, provided, however, that no non-resident person, under the age of fourteen (14) years shall fish in or on any Wyoming waters without first having obtained a non-resident or tourist fishing license, UNLESS SUCH NON-RESIDENT PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF FOURTEEN (14) YEARS SHALL BE IN THE COMPANY OF AN ADULT IN POSSESSION OF A VALID UNEXPIRED WYOMING FISHING LICENSE IN WHICH CASE THE NON-RESIDENT PERSON UNDER FOURTEEN (14) YEARS SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO POSSESS A NON-RESIDENT OR TOURIST FISHING LICENSE, PROVIDED HOWEVER, THAT SUCH PERSON'S CREEL LIMIT OF FISH AS ESTABLISHED BY LAW OR BY

ORDERS OR REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE APPLIED TO
AND LIMITED BY THE ONE FISHING LICENSE HELD BY THE ADULT PER-
SON IN HIS COMPANY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section-1. That Section 47-203, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 88, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1949, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person of the age of fourteen (14) years or over to catch, pursue, or attempt to catch any fish in this State in any manner whatsoever without first having obtained a proper license or permit from the Commission; provided, however, that no non-resident person, under the age of fourteen (14) years shall fish in or on any Wyoming waters without first having obtained a non-resident or tourist fishing license, UNLESS SUCH NON-RESIDENT PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF FOURTEEN (14) YEARS SHALL BE IN THE COMPANY OF AN ADULT IN POSSESSION OF A VALID UNEXPIRED WYOMING FISHING LICENSE IN WHICH CASE THE NON-RESIDENT PERSON UNDER FOURTEEN (14) YEARS SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO POSSESS A NON-RESIDENT OR TOURIST FISHING LICENSE, PROVIDED HOWEVER, THAT SUCH PERSON'S CREEL LIMIT OF FISH AS ESTABLISHED BY LAW OR BY ORDERS OR REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE APPLIED TO AND LIMITED BY THE ONE FISHING LICENSE HELD BY THE ADULT PERSON IN HIS COMPANY.
