- 10 same time as the election for formation of the district.
- 11 There shall be elected a board of directors consisting of

- three (3) members who are residents and-property-owners
- 2 living within the district who shall serve without compen-
- 3 sation. Within ten (10) days after each election the
- 4 board shall meet and select a president and a secretary-
- 5 treasurer. The first elected board shall serve until the
- 6 next primary election. At the first primary election, one
- 7 (1) member of the board shall be elected for two (2)
- 8 years, and two (2) members for four (4) years, for stag-
- 9 gered terms. Thereafter, directors shall be elected for
- 10 four (4) year terms. Biennial elections shall be held
- 11 within the district at the time, place and in the manner
- 12 as defined by the board of directors in accordance with
