5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

6 Section 1. W.S. 35-9-202(a) is amended to read:

7 35-9-202. ELECTION OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

8 (a) The election of the initial board of directors
9 shall be held by the board of county commissioners at the
10 same time as the election for formation of the district.
11 There shall be elected a board of directors consisting of

1 three (3) members who are residents and-property-owners
2 living within the district who shall serve without compen-
3 sation. Within ten (10) days after each election the
4 board shall meet and select a president and a secretary-
5 treasurer. The first elected board shall serve until the
6 next primary election. At the first primary election, one
7 (1) member of the board shall be elected for two (2)
8 years, and two (2) members for four (4) years, for stag-
9 gered terms. Thereafter, directors shall be elected for
10 four (4) year terms. Biennial elections shall be held
11 within the district at the time, place and in the manner
12 as defined by the board of directors in accordance with
13 chapter 29 of the Wyoming Election Code of 1973.

14 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 1995.
