5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

6 Section 1. W.S. 11-31-301(b)(ii) and (c) is amended
 7 to read:

8 11-31-301. Public nuisance; notice; penalties; rules
 9 and regulations; animal control districts and officers.

10 (b) Notice of such a declaration shall be published
 11 in a newspaper of general circulation within the county

1 and notices may be placed in appropriate locations. The
2 notice shall specify any regulations necessary and conve-
3 nient for animal control and shall state that:

4 (ii) A fine shall be imposed on the owner OR
5 CUSTODIAN of such animal and restitution for any damages
6 to person or property caused by the animal shall be made
7 by the owner OR CUSTODIAN;

8 (c) Upon the filing of any complaint, the county
9 sheriff may arrest or issue a summons to the owner OR CUS-
10 TODIAN of any animal which is running at large or has
11 attacked a person. A first conviction is punishable by a
12 fine of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00). Each subse-
13 quent conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than
14 one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

15 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
16 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
17 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Consti-
18 tution.


