Enrolled Act No. 111, House of Representatives

TWENTY-FOURTH LEGISLATURE OF
THE STATE OF WYOMING

AN ACT relating to striping state highways and prescribing duties of the State Highway Superintendent relative thereto.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. The State Highway Superintendent shall cause all state highways completed in oil, concrete or other hard surface to be striped with a broken line of conspicuous color, not less than four inches wide, and said striping shall be renewed as necessary; said line to be in the center of and parallel to the highway, and providing further that all striping on grades and curves be continuous.

Section 2. All Acts and parts of Acts in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
