- 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
- 8 Section 1. W.S. 9-2-1410 is created to read:
- 9 9-2-1410. WYOMING CUSTOMIZED AND EXISTING INDUSTRY
- 10 TRAINING PROGRAM; CREATION; POLICY; FUNCTIONS.
- 11 (a) There is hereby created the Wyoming customized

- 1 and existing industry training program within the division
- of economic and community development. The program shall
- 3 be administered by the division in cooperation with the
- 4 state community college commission and local community
- 5 colleges.
- 6 (b) The program shall provide for the training or
- 7 retraining of workers where training is deemed crucial for
- 8 new or existing employers and for worker retention. The
- 9 training may include preemployment training, training of
- 10 workers upon first being hired, retraining of workers for
- 11 new jobs, upgrade training and any additional training
- needed to accomplish the objectives of the program.
- 13 (c) Prior to any training under the program, an
- employer or potential employer shall agree to act as spon-
- sor in the development and implementation of the training
- 16 program. The participating employer may be requested to
- 17 contribute technical expertise, equipment, training space,
- monies, in-kind support and other appropriate resources in
- order to improve program effectiveness.
- 20 (d) Training under the program may duplicate existing
- 21 course offerings provided by the local community college.
- 22 If there is a duplication, payment from funds available

- 1 under the program shall be limited to tuition and any
- 2 course fees. If a local community college does not have
- 3 the resources to deliver the training required by the
- 4 employer, the college may contract with other qualified
- 5 entities, public or private.
- 6 (e) The payment of all direct costs of training pro-
- 7 grams specified in subsection (b) of this section shall be
- 8 made from funds available for the Wyoming customized and
- 9 existing industry training program. Direct training costs
- 10 shall include:
- 11 (i) Assessment and testing, including adult
- 12 basic skills testing;
- 13 (ii) Instructor wages, per diem and travel;
- 14 (iii) Curriculum development and training mate-
- 15 rials;
- 16 (iv) Lease of training equipment and training
- 17 space.
- 18 (f) Administrative expenses connected with the train-
- ing programs shall be allowable costs and may be reim-
- 20 bursed up to fifteen percent (15%) of total program cost.
- 21 Funds of the Wyoming customized and existing industry

- 1 training program shall not be used to pay wages or sti-
- 2 pends to trainees during a training session.
- 3 (g) Training assistance shall be encouraged for small
- 4 and rural companies but shall not be limited to those com-
- 5 panies.
- 6 (h) The community colleges are authorized to accept,
- 7 receive and expend grants, gifts and monies not otherwise
- 8 limited, from any source for the purpose of implementing
- 9 the functions under this section.
- 10 (j) Beginning July 1, 1996, and each July 1 thereaf-
- 11 ter, the state community college commission and the divi-
- sion of economic and community development shall report to
- the legislature and the governor on the cost-effectiveness
- of the Wyoming customized and existing industry training
- 15 program.
- 16 Section 2. There is appropriated from the general
- 17 fund to the division of economic and community develop-
- 18 ment, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1995, the sum
- of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00), or so much
- 20 thereof as may be necessary, for the implementation of
- 21 this act.

- 1 Section 3. The legislature finds and declares that it
- 2 is the policy of Wyoming to promote the health, safety,
- 3 opportunity for gainful employment, business opportuni-
- 4 ties, increased productivity and general welfare of the
- 5 citizens of this state by the creation of the Wyoming cus-
- 6 tomized and existing industry training program.
- 7 Section 4. This act is effective July 1, 1995.
