Upon loss, mutilation 17 or destruction of a dealer plate or validation sticker the 18 dealer may obtain a replacement dealer plate or validation 19 sticker from the county treasurer from which he purchased 20 the original plate in the same manner as the owner of a 21 vehicle and upon payment of the appropriate fee under W.S. 22 31-3-102(a)(vi). Obtaining a replacement plate is not the 23 purchase of an additional plate under W.S. 31-2-301(f). Upon application for new license plates or stickers the 24

1 31-2-212. LOSS, MUTILATION OR DESTRUCTION OF REGIS-2 TRATION, PLATES OR VALIDATION STICKERS. Upon loss, mutila-3 tion or destruction of a certificate of registration, 4 license plate, or validation sticker the owner of a vehi-5 cle may obtain a duplicate certificate of registration, 6 new license plates or validation stickers from any county 7 treasurer or the department if the vehicle was registered 8 or plates or stickers were issued by the department upon 9 application showing the loss, mutilation or destruction, 10 return of mutilated plates or stickers and payment of the 11 duplicate registration, plate or sticker fee.
