GAME AND FISH-SPECIAL SET ASIDE ANTELOPE LICENSES

Original Senate File No. 96

AN ACT relating to game and fish; authorizing thirty antelope hunting licenses to be set aside for nonprofit organizations promoting hunting for individuals with disabilities; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 23-1-705 by creating a new subsection (h) is amended to read:

23-1-705. Complimentary licenses; one-shot antelope hunt licenses; gunpowder and buckskin hunt licenses; gratuitous licenses.

(h) In addition the commission may, upon receipt of payment of antelope license fees, issue up to a total of thirty (30) antelope licenses each year for the exclusive distribution by nonprofit organizations dedicated to providing hunting opportunities to individuals with disabilities for use by those individuals for hunting opportunities.

Section 2. This act is effective January 1, 2000.
