ADJUDICATION OF WATER RIGHTS

AN ACT to authorize the granting of a permit by the State Engineer of Wyoming, upon the application of John and Peter Etcheverry to store water of the State of Wyoming from Thomas Fork Creek, tributary of Bear River in the Enlargement of Thomas Fork Reservoir and a secondary permit for irrigation of lands, a portion of which is in the State of Idaho.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Permit To Store Additional Water

Section 1. That the State Engineer of the State of Wyoming is hereby authorized to approve upon a proper showing of fact and when prepared in proper form the applications of John and Peter Etcheverry of Cokeville, Wyoming, for permit to store and appropriate water of the State of Wyoming from Thomas Fork Creek, tributary of Bear River in the Enlargement of Thomas Fork Reservoir, to an additional capacity of five hundred sixty eight and five tenths (568.5) acre feet, and for secondary irrigation of lands, a portion of which is in the State of Idaho.

The Board of Control is hereby authorized to adjudicate the **water rights under said applications upon proper showing of completion of construction and completion of beneficial use of water.** This authorization is made to conform with Section 71-265 and 71-266, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945.
