SENATE JOINT MEMORIAL NO. 3.

Memorial to the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States Requesting Congress to Provide for the Immediate Construction of a System of Federal Highways.

Whereas, The Legislature of the State of Wyoming is firmly convinced that the present is the most opportune time to commence immediately upon the construction of a system of main Federal Highways to be constructed and maintained by the Government of the United States,

Therefore, Be It Resolved, By the Senate of the State of Wyoming, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Congress

of the United States be memorialized to take immediate steps in providing the necessary legislation;

Be it Further Resolved, That a copy of this memorial be sent to Honorable Francis E. Warren, Honorable John B. Kendrick and Honorable Frank W. Mondell, representatives in Congress from the State of Wyoming.
