- 11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 1 Section 1. W.S. 6-3-203 by creating new subsections
- 2 (f) and (g) is amended to read:
- 3 6-3-203. Cruelty to animals; penalties; limitation
- 4 on manner of destruction; persons authorized to enforce
- 5 section; care of animals; civil action for expenses; lien.
- 6 (f) IN ADDITION TO PEACE OFFICERS AUTHORIZED BY LAW
- 7 TO ENFORCE THIS SECTION, EVERY OFFICER AND AGENT OF THE
- 8 WYOMING LIVESTOCK BOARD IS AUTHORIZED AND EMPOWERED TO
- 9 ARREST WITHOUT WARRANT ANY PERSON FOUND VIOLATING THIS
- 10 SECTION. AN OFFICER OR AGENT OF THE WYOMING LIVESTOCK
- 11 BOARD MAKING AN ARREST UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL DELIVER

- 14 (g) ANY PEACE OFFICER OR ANY OFFICER OR AGENT OF THE
 - 15 WYOMING LIVESTOCK BOARD MAY TAKE POSSESSION OF ANY ANIMAL
 - 16 WHICH HE HAS REASONABLE CAUSE TO BELIEVE HAS BEEN ABAN-
 - 17 DONED, NEGLECTED OR CRUELLY TREATED AND MAY CARE AND PRO-
 - 18 VIDE FOR THE ANIMAL UNTIL THE OWNER TAKES CHARGE OF THE
 - 19 ANIMAL. THE REASONABLE EXPENSES OF THE CARE GIVEN AN ANI-
 - 20 MAL UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY BE RECOVERED FROM THE OWNER
 - 21 IN A CIVIL ACTION AND SHALL CONSTITUTE A LIEN AGAINST THE
