REORGANIZATION OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS

AN ACT to amend and re-enact Sections 13 and 17, Chapter 163, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1947, relating to number and types of schools to be operated in each new school district, and the territory to be included in school districts.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. That Section 13, Chapter 163, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1947, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Requirements—Operation of Schools

Section 13. Every new school district created pursuant to this Act must operate at least one (1) elementary school or one (1) high school and may operate as many elementary schools and as many high schools as shall be necessary to provide comprehensive educational facilities for the children of school age throughout the district.

Section 2. That Section 17, Chapter 163, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1947, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Territory Included In Districts

Section 17. Upon the reorganization of the school districts in each county all of the area and territory within the county shall be included within reorganized or presently organized districts each maintaining or to maintain at least one elementary school or high school.
