STANDARDS FOR SEEDS.

AN ACT to amend and re-enact Sections 3830, 3833, and 3834, Chapter 238, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1920, relating to standards for seeds, and testing of same.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. That Section 3830, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1920, is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Specifications for "Pure Seed."

Section 3830. Any seed sold for planting, that is marked "Pure Seed" shall conform to the following standards of purity and viability of agricultural seeds:

The standards of purity and viability of all other seeds shall be fixed by the Commissioner of Agriculture.

STATE OF WYOMING GENERAL SESSION 1929

Section 2. That Section 3833, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1920, is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Tests by State Chemist.

Section 3833. It shall be the duty of the State Chemist to make, or cause to be made under his direction, tests of such agricultural seeds as may be submitted to him by the State Department of Agriculture, Dairy, Food and Oil Division, and the certificate of said State Chemist setting forth the results of any examination or test of any seed sample, shall be presumptive evidence of the facts therein stated.

Section 3. That Section 3834, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1920, is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Report of Chemist.

Section 3834. When said State Chemist, shall find by his examination or tests that any person, firm or corporation has violated any of the provisions of this chapter, the chief of the Dairy, Food and Oil Division, State Department of Agriculture, may transmit the facts so found to the County and Prosecuting Attorney of the county in which the offense was committed, or the misbranded seeds were found.

Section 4. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
