- Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 10

- 1 Section 1. W.S. 29-2-110 is created to read:
- penalty. Any original contractor or subcontractor who receives money from the owner, owners or agent and does not apply the money toward construction costs is guilty of misappropriation and shall be sentenced to not less than one (1) or more than ten (10) years in the penitentiary, or fined not less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or more than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00), or both.

29-2-110. Misappropriation of monies by contractor;

- 10 Lien waivers signed by all materialmen, subcontractors and
