1 A JOINT RESOLUTION requesting Congress to provide adequate
2 funding for the National Endowment for the Arts, the
3 National Endowment for the Humanities and the Institute
4 for Museum Services.

5 WHEREAS, the people of Wyoming have benefited from the
6 development of stronger and more accessible arts activity
7 in every county of the state because of the assistance
8 provided by the Wyoming Arts Council with support from the
9 National Endowment for the Arts; and

10 WHEREAS, National Endowment for the Arts funding of
11 \$601,300.00 in fiscal year 1994 combined with \$296,281.00
12 provided by the state helped generate \$12.3 million in

1 cash from local Wyoming communities; and

2 WHEREAS, the fiscal year 1994 audience for arts activ-
3 ities in Wyoming exceeded 1,135,000 citizens and tourists;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, beyond the intrinsic value of arts education,
6 the teaching of art in the schools develops higher order
7 thinking, creativity and problem solving in students or
8 skills that carry over into all area of study; and

9 WHEREAS, thousands of Wyoming school children of all
10 ages benefit from quality arts activities assisted by
11 National Endowment for the Arts funding awarded through
12 the Wyoming Arts Council; and

13 WHEREAS, funding by the National Endowment for the
14 Arts through the Wyoming Arts Council helps Wyoming
15 artists gain regional and national attention; and

16 WHEREAS, direct National Endowment for the Arts fund-
17 ing assists some of Wyoming's major arts institutions who
18 bring national and international attention to the state
19 for their artistic achievements; and

20 WHEREAS, National Endowment for the Arts funding in
21 Wyoming and in other parts of the nation has enabled arts

1 organizations to win matching support from private
2 sources; and

3 WHEREAS, all great nations support the arts knowing
4 the arts are vital to a society's well-being and Congress
5 in 1965 noted "An advanced civilization must . . . give
6 understanding of the past, a better analysis of the pres-
7 ent, and a better view of the future".

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE LEG-
9 ISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

10 Section 1. That the Congress of the United States of
11 America is encouraged to reauthorize continuation of the
12 National Endowment for the Arts and its sister agencies,
13 the National Endowment for the Humanities and the Insti-
14 tute for Museum Services, and to provide adequate funding
15 to enable them to continue their leadership roles in our
16 nation on behalf of our country's culture.

1 Section 2. That the Secretary of State of Wyoming
2 transmit copies of this resolution to the President of the
3 United States, to the President of the Senate and the
4 Speaker of the House of Representatives of the United
5 States Congress and to the Wyoming Congressional Delegation.
