1 AN ACT to amend W.S. 39-6-308(a) and (b); and to repeal
2 W.S. 39-6-308(c) relating to the municipal mineral trust
3 fund; converting the municipal rainy day account to a
4 municipal mineral trust fund; creating the distribution
5 formula for the municipal mineral trust fund; repealing
6 the distribution formula for the municipal rainy day
7 account; and providing for an effective date.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 Section 1. W.S. 39-6-308(a) and (b) is amended to
10 read:

11 39-6-308. Municipal mineral trust fund.

1 (a) There is created within the earmarked revenue
2 fund a municipal rainy-day-account MINERAL TRUST FUND to
3 be funded as follows:

4 (i) When the amount of the oil and gas severance
5 tax distributed to cities and towns in any fiscal year
6 under W.S. 39-6-305(k) (i) exceeds twenty-four million dol-
7 lars (\$24,000,000.00) then one-half (1/2) of the amount
8 over twenty-four million dollars (\$24,000,000.00) which
9 would have gone to cities and towns shall be transferred
10 to the municipal rainy-day-account MINERAL TRUST FUND and
11 one-half (1/2) of the amount shall be distributed to cit-
12 ies and towns in the same manner as the first twenty-four
13 million dollars (\$24,000,000.00) is distributed; and

14 (ii) When the amount of federal mineral royal-
15 ties distributed in any fiscal year exceeds two hundred
16 million dollars (\$200,000,000.00), then one-half (1/2) of
17 the amount that would normally be distributed to cities
18 and towns under W.S. 9-4-601(d) (i) shall be transferred to
19 the municipal rainy-day-account MINERAL TRUST FUND and
20 one-half (1/2) of the amount that would normally be dis-
21 tributed to cities and towns shall be distributed pursuant
22 to W.S. 9-4-601(d) (i).

1 (b) The state treasurer shall invest these monies in
2 the municipal rainy-day-~~account~~ MINERAL TRUST FUND in the
3 same manner as other state monies are invested. Any
4 interest earned on investment of the municipal rainy-day
5 ~~account~~ MINERAL TRUST FUND monies shall be deposited in
6 the ~~account~~ FUND. EIGHTY PERCENT (80%) OF THE ANNUAL
7 INTEREST DEPOSITED IN THE MUNICIPAL MINERAL TRUST FUND
8 SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO CITIES AND TOWNS IN WYOMING ON A
9 QUARTERLY BASIS AS FOLLOWS:

10 (i) TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT (25%) SHALL BE DISTRIB-
11 UTED EQUALLY AMONG ALL CITIES AND TOWNS IN WYOMING;

12 (ii) SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT (75%) SHALL BE DIS-
13 TRIBUTED TO CITIES AND TOWNS IN THE PROPORTION WHICH THE
14 POPULATION OF THE CITY OR TOWN BEARS TO THE POPULATION OF
15 ALL CITIES AND TOWNS IN WYOMING, BASED UPON THE MOST
16 RECENT FEDERAL DECENNIAL CENSUS.

17 Section 2. W.S. 39-6-308(c) is repealed.

1 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Consti-
4 tution.
