

CHAPTER 40

Original House Bill No. 123

FREMONT COUNTY QUIET TITLE ACTION

AN ACT authorizing and consenting that the State of Wyoming may be sued by Fremont County Vocational High School, State of Wyoming, a body corporate, and others, in order to quiet title to certain real property in Fremont County, Wyoming; and directing the Attorney General to enter a general appearance in any such action or actions on behalf of the State of Wyoming and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Consent By State to Be Sued

Section 1. The State of Wyoming hereby authorizes and consents that it may be sued and made a party defendant in a civil action to quiet title to real property described as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, Township 33 North, Range 100 West, Sixth Principal Meridian in Fremont County, Wyoming.

Attorney General to Enter a General Appearance

Section 2. The Attorney General of the State of Wyoming is hereby authorized and directed to enter a general appearance in any such action regarding the real property described, for and on behalf of the State of Wyoming; and to take such appropriate action as he may deem necessary.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
