Original House Bill No. 232.

APPROPRIATION FOR RELIEF ON ACCOUNT OF RATE MEETING.

AN ACT making appropriations for relief for the two years ending March 31, 1927 for the following: Chamber of Commerce at Casper, Wyoming, Chamber of Commerce at Sheridan, Wyoming, Chamber of Commerce at Buffalo, Wyoming. The Mills Company, Mountain States Telephone and Telegraph Company, Burroughs Adding Machine Company, Mrs. T. B. Hood, and Dildine Garage Company.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. That the sum of Seven Hundred Eighty Dollars and Thirty-six Cents be and is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the payment of the following relief claims:

Chamber of Commerce at Casper, Wyoming, for expense of rate meeting, Two Hundred Sixty Dollars and Fifty-nine Cents.

Chamber of Commerce at Sheridan, Wyoming, for expense of rate meeting, Two Hundred Thirty-nine Dollars.

Chamber of Commerce at Buffalo, Wyoming, for expense of rate meeting, Fifty Dollars.

The Mills Company, Sheridan, Wyoming, for printing, One Hundred Twenty-four Dollars and Fifty Cents.

Mountain States Telephone and Telegraph Company, Cheyenne, Wyoming, for telephone, Five Dollars and Forty Cents.

Burroughs Adding Machine Company, Cheyenne, Wyoming, for repairs to machine, Twenty-six Dollars and Forty-five Cents.

Mrs. T. B. Hood, Cheyenne, Wyoming, traveling expense, Thirty-seven Dollars and Thirty-two Cents.

Dildine Garage Company, Cheyenne, Wyoming, for auto hire, Thirty-seven Dollars and Ten Cents.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
