It shall be the duty of the secretary of the State board of charities and reform to include in *his* annual report to the Governor an itemized account of all expenditures made during the current year for the institutions under the supervision of such board, making a complete and separate statement of the ex-

penditures made for each of such institutions, according to the appropriations made, so that the cost of the support and maintenance of the same may be easily ascertained. <sup>They</sup> He shall also include <sup>their</sup> in his report in each even numbered year an itemized estimate of the amount deemed necessary by the board to be appropriated for the support and maintenance of each of the institutions under its supervision for the ensuing two years, which estimate shall be made and itemized according to the appropriations made for the two preceding years so that it may readily be compared with the expenditures and appropriations for those years.

Sec. 4. All appropriations hereafter made for the support and maintenance of the several penal, charitable and reformatory institutions under the supervision of the state board of charities and reform shall state separately the amount appropriated for each institution; and it shall be the duty of the state auditor to keep a separate account showing <sup>of each</sup> the appropriations for ~~each~~ of such institutions, and all expenditures in connection therewith.

Sec. 5. <sup>4</sup> This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
