for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION relating to recycling; calling upon the
2 Wyoming Legislature to reduce paper usage and to recycle.

3 WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Wyoming has
4 called upon the executive branch to reduce paper usage by
5 thirty percent (30%) and to recycle paper; and

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes the importance to
7 the environment of reducing paper usage and recycling
8 paper whenever possible.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE LEG-
