No prop-11 erty shall be disposed of at less than current appraised 12 13 value either for cash or in exchange for credit upon purchase of new property or equipment. All sales shall 14 public and based upon adequate notice EXCEPT THAT FOR THE 15 FIRST ONE HUNDRED TWENTY (120) DAYS ANY PERSONAL PROPERTY 16 17 MAY BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THOSE ENTITIES QUALIFYING UNDER 18 FEDERAL SURPLUS PROPERTY GUIDELINES THROUGH THE FEDERAL 19 SURPLUS PROPERTY WAREHOUSE. The proceeds of sale or sales, LESS COST OF SALE, shall be remitted to the treas-20 urer for the benefit of the fund from which the supplies, 21 22 materials, equipment or property was purchased. The provisions of this subparagraph PARAGRAPH shall not apply to, 23
