6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 Section 1. W.S. 9-3-2021(b)(iv) is amended to read:

8 9-3-2021. Powers, duties and functions of purchasing
9 and property control division; board of state supplies,
10 superintendent of buildings and grounds, and surplus prop-

1 erty agency abolished; creation and powers of surplus
2 property section.

3 (b) The department through the purchasing and prop-
4 erty control division shall perform the following duties:

5 (iv) Supervise and approve disposition by sale
6 or trade-in of all state agencies' supplies, materials,
7 equipment or property which have become useless to the
8 state, provided that the disposition of real property in
9 excess of forty (40) acres in one (1) tract or valued at
10 fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) or more shall be
11 authorized by the capitol building commission. No prop-
12 erty shall be disposed of at less than current appraised
13 value either for cash or in exchange for credit upon pur-
14 chase of new property or equipment. All sales shall be
15 public and based upon adequate notice EXCEPT THAT FOR THE
16 FIRST ONE HUNDRED TWENTY (120) DAYS ANY PERSONAL PROPERTY
17 MAY BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THOSE ENTITIES QUALIFYING UNDER
18 FEDERAL SURPLUS PROPERTY GUIDELINES THROUGH THE FEDERAL
19 SURPLUS PROPERTY WAREHOUSE. The proceeds of sale or
20 sales, LESS COST OF SALE, shall be remitted to the treas-
21 urer for the benefit of the fund from which the supplies,
22 materials, equipment or property was purchased. The provi-
23 sions of this ~~subparagraph~~ PARAGRAPH shall not apply to,

1 nor shall the department approve or supervise the disposi-
2 tion of land by the state highway commission pursuant to
3 W.S. 24-2-109;

4 Section 2. Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00)
5 is appropriated from the general fund for the purposes of
6 this act.

7 Section 3. This act is effective May 20, 1981.
