



1 A JOINT RESOLUTION requesting Congress to propose an  
 2 amendment to the United State Constitution for ratifica-  
 3 tion by the state legislatures which grants power to Con-  
 4 gress and the states to prohibit desecration of the United  
 5 States Flag.

6 WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court in the deci-  
 7 sion Texas v. Johnson, 109 S. Ct. 2533 (1989), held that a  
 8 conviction under a state statute for flag burning as a  
 9 means of expressive conduct is inconsistent with the First  
 10 Amendment;

11 WHEREAS, the United States Flag is a visible symbol of  
 12 the nation's fight for freedom, signifies peace and pride

1 of America, and is regarded with respect and affection by  
2 millions of Americans;

3 WHEREAS, the United States Flag is used as a symbol of  
4 respect, pride and honor on postal stamps, courtroom  
5 decor, ships, public buildings and caskets of deceased  
6 members of the armed forces;

7 WHEREAS, the desecration of the United States Flag by  
8 any means and for any reason is disgraceful and cannot be  
9 tolerated or go unpunished as it is offensive to the  
10 majority of Americans who respect the ideals inspired by  
11 the Flag and who desire to preserve the reverence of the  
12 Flag;

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE LEG-  
14 ISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

15 Section 1. That the Congress of the United States  
16 propose an amendment to the United States Constitution for  
17 ratification by at least three-fourths of the state legis-  
18 latures which grants power to the Congress and the states  
19 to regulate, protect and prohibit the desecration in any  
20 manner and for any purpose of the United States Flag and  
21 to impose criminal penalties.



1           Section 2. That the Secretary of State send copies of  
2   this resolution to the President of the United States, the  
3   President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of  
4   Representatives of the United States Congress and to each  
5   member of the Wyoming Congressional Delegation.
