7 **Section 1.** W.S. 14-6-429(c)(i) is amended to read:

- 9 14-6-429. Decree where child adjudged in need of
- 10 supervision; dispositions; terms and conditions; legal
- 11 custody.

- 13 (c) In cases where a child is ordered removed from the
- 14 child's home:

- 16 (i) If a child is committed or transferred to an

1	(A) At least every three (3) months the
2	agency or institution shall recommend to the court if the
3	order should be continued;

5	(B) Not less than once every twelve (12)
6	months, the court of jurisdiction shall conduct a formal
7	review to assess and determine the appropriateness of the
8	current placement, the reasonable efforts made to reunify
9	the family, the safety of the child and the permanency plan
10	for the child. Placements at the Wyoming state hospital are
11	exempt from the review required by this subparagraph.

13	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 1999.
