- 6 (i) Name of the person notifying the system;
- 7 (ii) Name, address and telephone number of the
- 8 excavator;
- 9 (iii) Location, starting date and description of
- 10 the intended activity.
- 11 (d) A person shall, upon receipt of the notice pro-
- vided for in subsection (c) of this section, advise the
- 13 excavator of the location, and size, depth, function and
- other relevant characteristics of underground facilities,
- 15 such as contents, pressure, voltage and material composi-
- tion in the proposed excavation area by-marking and shall
- 17 mark the location of the facilities with stakes, paint or
- by other clearly identifiable marking within eighteen (18)
