- 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
- 9 Section 1. W.S. 21-17-112 and 21-18-102 are created 10 to read:

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1	21-17-112. Partial tuition payments for members of a
2	military reserve unit; administration.

- (a) Upon written application the university may authorize the payment of up to fifty percent (50%) of resident student tuition fees for members of a military reserve component on active status upon the following terms and conditions: 7
- (i) The authorization shall be issued by the 8 university prior to each semester of school with the pay-9 ment to be made by reimbursement to the reserve member; 10
- (ii) The program is available to active mili-11 tary reserve members other than members of the Wyoming 12 National Guard who are classified as full-time or part-13 time students attending the university; 14
 - (iii) Eligibility for benefits is determined by the member's good standing in the specific military component as certified to the university by the member's commanding officer at the time of application and throughout the entire semester for which benefits are received;
- (iv) The military member's eligibility 20 tuition benefits is limited to eight (8) semesters or 21

Section 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to an earmarked revenue account established pursuant to W.S. 9-7-504(a)(ii) the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) to be administered by the state treasurer. Upon receipt of verification from the University of Wyoming or from a community college of a reserve member's eliqibility for benefits provided by this act. the payment will be made to the eliqible military reserve member by the state treasurer.

Section 3. This act is effective May 20. 1981.
