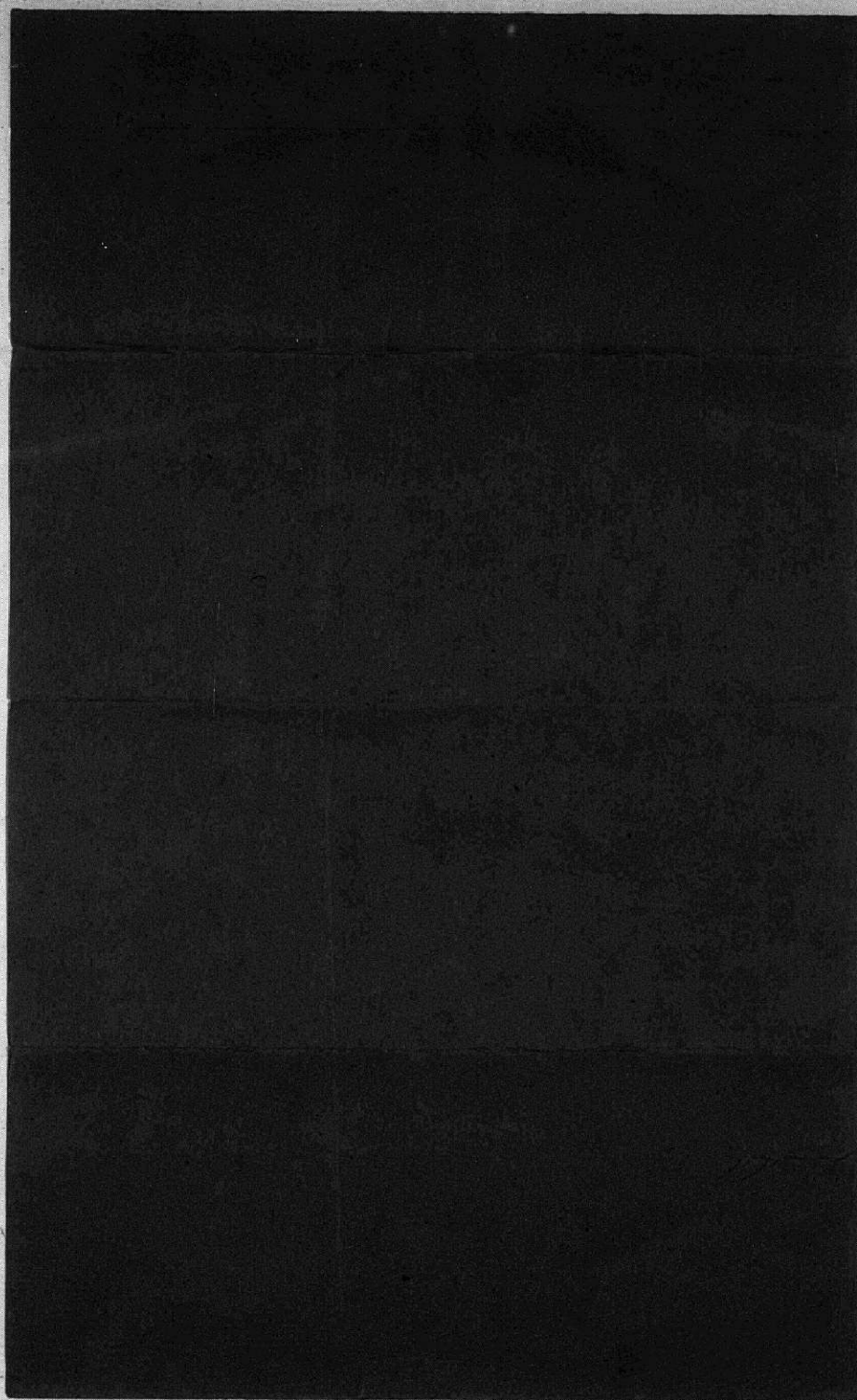

A BILL

FOR

AN ACT to amend and re-enact subsections (a) and (b), Section 13, Chapter 162, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1947, as amended by Chapter 59, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1951, relating to driver's license fees and the expiration date of licenses and providing an effective date for this Act.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING

Section 1. That subsection (a), Section 13, Chapter 162, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1947, as amended by Chapter 59, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1951, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

13 (a). Every applicant for a driver's license shall pay for such driver's license a license fee of * * * TWO DOLLARS (\$2.00) which shall be the cost of such driver's license, and every driver's license hereafter issued shall expire on the birth anniversary of the licensee occurring within the third year after the year in which such license is issued, unless revoked, cancelled or suspended under the provisions of * * * ANY LAW OF THIS STATE. Every such license shall be renewable within ninety (90) days prior to its expiration upon application and payment of the required fee.

Section 2. That subsection (b), Section 13, Chapter 162, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1947, as amended by Chapter 59, Session Laws of Wyoming, 1951, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

13 (b). Every * * * APPLICANT for a chauffeur's license shall pay for such chauffeur's license a license fee of * * * TWO DOLLARS (\$2.00), which license shall expire one (1) year from the date of its issue, unless revoked, cancelled or suspended under the provisions of * * * ANY LAW OF THIS STATE. Every such license shall be renewable sixty (60) days prior to its expiration upon application and payment of the required fee.

Section 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force on and after its passage.
